

# Oceanside Schools Film Festival- Shorts 2010

---

**1. CONTEST PERIOD:** All submissions must be handed in to the library media specialist in your building by **3pm on February 3<sup>rd</sup> 2010**. You will be notified whether your submission will be shown at the festival. The film festival will take place in the Oceanside High School Auditorium at **7pm on April 8<sup>th</sup> 2010**.

**2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:** Participants must have their film screened by a parent or staff member who will sign off on the appropriateness of the film prior to submission. In addition, parent/guardian release forms must be submitted by each participant in order to be part of the film festival. This permission is provided with the understanding that this work may be presented to the public, posted to the web, and/or televised. **\*No film will be accepted if it is deemed degrading, illegal, or demoralizing, or if during the filming process anyone was at risk of bodily or emotional harm.**

**3. CATEGORIES:** Film entries must fall under one of these categories:

Suspense	Travel Film	Animation/Claymation
Silent Film	Newscast	Comedy
Mystery	Documentary	Musical
Foreign Film (with subtitles)	Commercial	Public Service Announcement

**4. CRITERIA FOR ENTRY:**

The film may be no longer than 4 minutes in length.

The completed film must be burned onto a CDR or DVD with your name, grade, school, category and title on the CD.

Films must be submitted in AVI, MPEG, Quicktime, WMV or MOV format.

If the film is included in the Foreign Film category, English subtitles must be on the final copy.

Title and credits must be included in the film. (Cite all music, images and copyrighted material.)

All release forms must be submitted along the final copy of the film.

All submissions will be made to the library-media specialist in your school by the due date.

**ELEMENTARY CRITERIA:** (in addition to the above)

The Elementary theme is **“Together We Can...”**

Each 6<sup>th</sup> grade class is eligible to participate by creating a 1 minute short film per class, related to the theme listed above.

All elementary films will be presented at the film festival, but will not be judged.

Library-media specialists are to send all entrees to the High School Library labeled **FILM FESTIVAL** by **3pm on February 3<sup>rd</sup> 2010**.

**5. JUDGING:** Film submissions will be reviewed by a committee of teachers and administrators. A rating system has been developed to determine eligibility and to ensure that the material contained in the film is appropriate. Only the best submissions in each category from the Middle and High School will be shown at the film festival. The winning films will be chosen by the committee, but the results will remain secret until the night of the festival.

**6. PRIZES:** The winning films maybe posted on our district web site and/or shown on television. Grand prize winners from each category at both the middle and high school levels will receive a **Foovie Awards** at the event.

**7. VOTING:** All finalists will be eligible for a special **“Audience Choice Award”** the night of the film festival. The audience will have an opportunity to choose the winner of this award.

**8. NOTIFICATION OF FINALISTS:** Students will receive notice prior to the film festival indicating whether or not their submission has been accepted.
